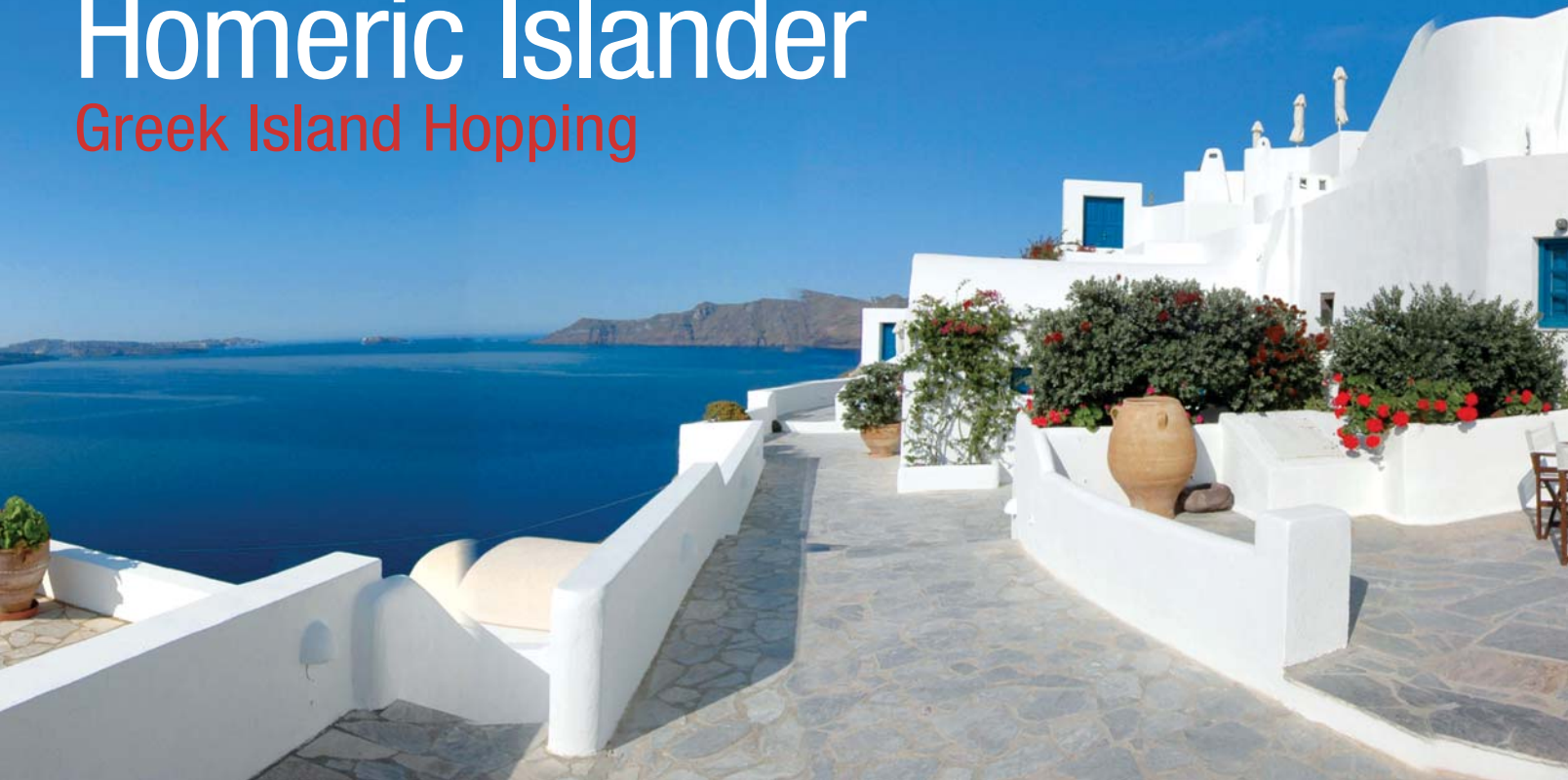

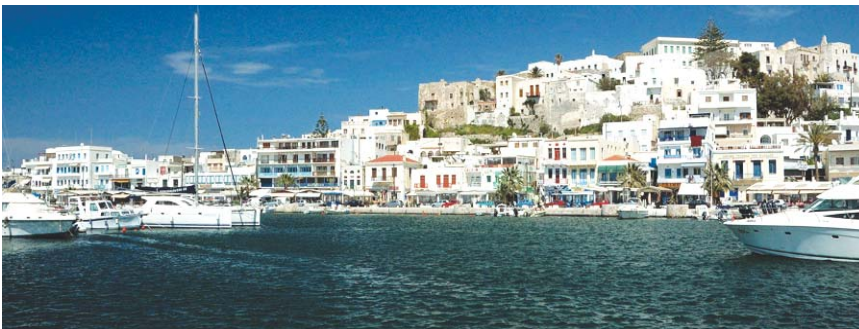
Santorini
