## DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:

### DAY 1, THU – ISTANBUL:

Upon arrival in Istanbul, You will be met and transferred to your hotel.

### DAY 2, FRI – ISTANBUL:

After breakfast, board the motor coach for a full day tour of Istanbul. Visits include St. Sophia Church, now a museum, Blue Mosque, Turkish Art Museums, Hippodrome and Grande Bazaar. Lunch included. Evening at leisure. (B,L)

### DAY 3, SAT – ISTANBUL:

Transfer to the pier and board on your cruise ship, where you will spend the night. Enjoy dinner and entertainment on board. (B,D)

### DAY 4, SUN – ISTANBUL / AT SEA:

Today enjoy shipboard activities and meals or take the time to explore Istanbul before departure. (B,L,D)

### DAY 5, MON – IZMIR:

Arrive in Izmir where you may take an optional excursion to the ancient city of Ephesus. (B,L,D)

### DAY 6, TUE – PATMOS / MYKONOS:

Arrive in Patmos where you can take an optional excursion to the Monastery and Cave where John the Divine wrote the Book of Revelation. Sail on to Mykonos, where you can enjoy a fun-filled afternoon and evening. Walk the cobblestone streets, visit the many shops or enjoy dinner at a local taverna. (B,L,D)

### DAY 7, WED – RHODES:

Arrive in Rhodes where you will spend a full day. Take an optional excursion of the city of Rhodes and the Acropolis of Lindos to visit the Temple of Athena. (B,L,D)

### DAY 8, THU – HERAKLION / SANTORINI:

Arrive in Heraklion, the capital of Crete. Take an optional excursion to the Palace of King Minos at Knossos, the center of the Minoan civilization. Sail on to Santorini, the volcano island, one of the most unforgettable places in the world. Walk along the narrow streets of the town of Thera or visit the beautiful village of Oia, perched on the rim of the caldera offering panoramic views of breathtaking beauty. (B,L,D)

### DAY 9, FRI – PIRAEUS / ATHENS:

Disembark after breakfast and transfer to the hotel in Athens. Spend the day at leisure or explore this fascinating city on your own. (B)

### DAY 10, SAT – ATHENS:

Begin today with an Athens city tour. Visits include the Acropolis and the Acropolis Museum, Panathinaikon Stadium and much more. Return to your hotel in the early afternoon. Rest of the day at leisure. (B)
