DAY 1 – USA / LISBON

Your overnight, transatlantic flight leaves the USA tonight.

DAY 2 – LISBON

Arrive Lisbon. You will be met and transferred to the city for a tour of Lisbon. You will see the old quarters of Alfama Moorish, Baixa, Praca do Comercio, Belem quarter with its monuments, Jeronimos Monastery and the Belem Tower. The remainder of the day is at leisure. This evening enjoy dinner and Fado show. Overnight Lisbon.

DAY 3 – LISBON / SINTRA / CASCAIS / ESTORIL / LISBON

After breakfast begin your full day tour to Sintra, a town with many palaces and castles to enchant. On the way to Sintra, a World Heritage site, you will pass Estoril and Cascais. Stop at cape Cabo da Roca where you can enjoy unforgettable views. Return to Lisbon for overnight. (B)

DAY 4 – LISBON/ OBIDOS / ALCOBACA / NAZARE / BATALHA / LISBON

Depart in the morning towards Obidos to visit this medieval village. Continue to Alcobaca and visit the church of the monastery of Santa Maria, a World Heritage site. Proceed to Nazare, one of the Portuguese most typical and colorful fishing villages. Continue to Batalha and visit the splendid Santa Maria da Vitoria Monastery, also a UNESCO World Heritage site. Return to Lisbon for overnight. (B)

DAY 5 – LISBON/ EVORA / LISBON

Today drive to Evora, a UNESCO World Heritage walled city. Visit the ancient Roman Temple, dating back to the 3rd century AD and the Chapel of Bones. Stop at a wine cellar for wine tasting before returning to Lisbon for overnight. (B)

DAY 6 – LISBON (OPTIONAL EXCURSION TO FATIMA)

You can spend today walking through the cosmopolitan streets of Lisbon or take an optional to one of the most visited shrines of the Catholic faith – the city of Fatima. Visit of the city, where in 1917 three poor shepherd children Lucia, Giaginta and Francisco, witnessed the apparition of the Madonna. Individual visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima and the Chapel of the Apparitions, which houses the statue of the Virgin Mary and the crown which you can glimpse the bullet that wounded Pope John Paul II in 1981.

DAY 7 – LISBON / USA

After breakfast transfer to the airport for a flight back home. (B)
