United States citizens traveling to Greece require a valid passport only. It is recommended that the passport be valid at least (6) months. You will need to check with your consulate to verify all requirements. It is suggested that ALL participants check with the appropriate Consulates to determine if any visas are required. Those taking one of our Egypt and/or Turkey tours require a visa and should obtain one prior to departure.

IMPORTANT: Passengers requiring a Schengen visa MUST have a multi entry Schengen visa.

CURRENCY:

The unit of currency is the euro. Coinage is used in denominations of 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 and 50 cents with 1 and 2 euros. Bank notes come in units of 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200 and 500 euros. It is not necessary to exchange your money prior to your arrival in Athens.
